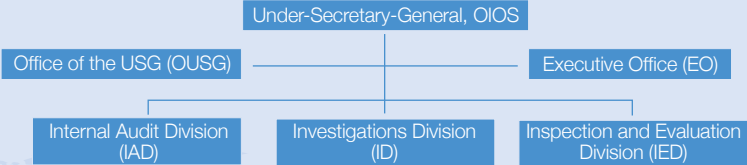


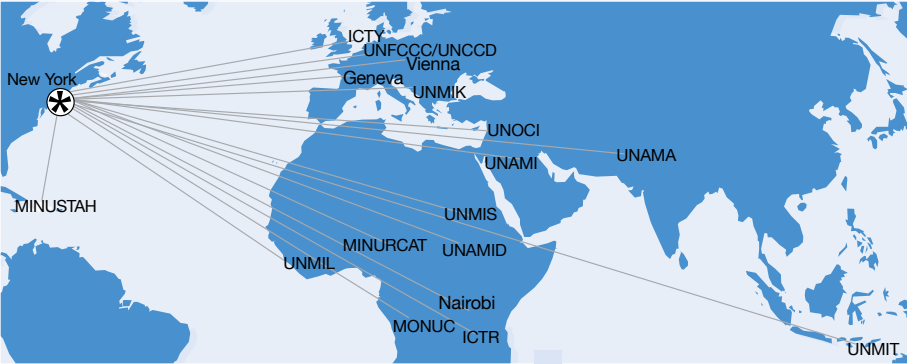
OIOS ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

THE UN WORKS TO MAKE THE WORLD A BETTER PLACE

The United Nations is credited with negotiating 172 peaceful settlements that have ended regional conflicts. *(source: UNA)*

More than 30 million refugees fleeing war, famine or persecution have received aid from UNHCR. *(source: United Nations)*

UN-Habitat programmes improved living conditions for 4.7 million people in 3,258 communities. *(source: United Nations)*

Since 1945, United Nations peacekeepers have undertaken 63 field missions, which enabled people in more than 45 countries to participate in free and fair elections, and helped disarm more than 400,000 ex-combatants in the past decade alone. *(source: United Nations)*
